

?      **Sermon Title: “The Healer Still Heals”**

**Scripture:**

*“He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.”*  
—Psalm 147:3 (KJV)

**Message:**

We often think of healing as something only the body needs — a cure for pain, sickness, or disease. But God reminds us that **He also heals the heart**. When we are broken by loss, disappointment, or sin, He is the One who binds up our wounds with love and grace.

Jesus spent much of His ministry healing — not only restoring physical health but also forgiving sins and giving peace to troubled souls. When He healed the blind, the lame, or the leper, He showed us that **no sickness, no hurt, and no past is beyond His touch**.

Sometimes God heals instantly; other times He heals over time. But always, His healing begins when we **trust Him** — when we let Him reach the places no doctor can touch: our hearts.

**Story:**

A young woman once came to church every Sunday with a heavy heart. She had lost her husband unexpectedly and couldn’t understand why. For months she prayed for God to take away her pain, but it stayed.
